### **Call for Senior Faculty Members (Research Visits in Europe)**

6 senior faculty members will be selected to conduct research visits for one month in one of the following European universities: University of Limoges, France; Bangor University, UK; University of Rome III, Italy; Technical University of Crete, Greece, to increase their international exposure to higher research standards and to gain new expertise in conducting applied research in the field of banking and finance.

#### **Requirements**

1. Permanent Academic Staff of an Indonesian university. Priority will be given to those affiliated with the following universities:  
Universitas Sebelas Maret; Institut Teknologi Bandung; Universitas Islam Negeri Syarif Hidayatullah; Universitas Syiah Kuala; Universitas Sriwijaya; Universitas Tanjungpura
2. Educational attainment: Doctoral Degree in Economics, Business, Finance, Accounting, or other related fields
3. Fluent in English (oral and written)
4. Has a strong background in conducting research, preferably in the field of banking and finance – has published at least 2 papers in reputable journal(s)
5. Exhibits strong interest in the field of banking and finance

3. 2-3 pages of research proposal in the field of banking and finance
4. Recommendation letter from the Dean
5. English certificate (IELTS or TOEFL)
6. Published/ working papers
